Salamansar Septem Ignis Single Malt Whisky bott code: L99 db (86) n21.5 t22.5 f20.5 b21.5 A little kink in the distillation is revealed on both nose and finish. But no quibbles about the barley intensity which rises like mercury in the Sahara... 45%.

Salamansar Single Cask Whisky Batch no. 1 triple wood Jamaican rum finish, bott code: L19/22 db (94.5) n23.5 what the...? Possibly the rummiest rum nose I have ever encountered in a whisky. And, unmistakably Jamaican in style. And top quality Pot Still rum to boot...! t24 sensuous and honey-laden, a light estery sheen coats the mouth while a succession of vanilla and golden syrup tones pad around the palate; creamy butterscotch takes us towards the finish; f23 Worther's Original candy meets a heather-honey and golden syrup hybrid, again with a rum-like estery depth keeping things chewy; b24 most whiskies which claim "rum finish" or "Jamaican Rum finish" rarely show little more than a firm, sugary coating. This reminds me of the days in the early '90s when i was in Jamaica putting rum together. This has a kind of Longpond feel to it, with its elongated sweetness and gentle esters. Adorable whisky, which was very well distilled, incidentally. 42% sc.

Salamansar Single Malt Whisky Batch no. 3 triple wood, bott code: L19/24 db (85.5) n22 t23 f19 b21.5 If they didn't know in Germany what a British "Jammy Dodger" smells like, then they do now. Fat, mildly unctuous and makes excellent play between the barley, grape and vanillas. Until the finale this is creamy, jammy and entertaining. Such a shame about the late sulphurous intervention. 43.7% sc.
